Itinerary

Day 1: Start in Poprad or Krakow, then transfer to your hotel in Levoca, Slovakia!

Meet our driver at your **preferred airport** and enjoy **hassle-free transport** directly to your hotel in Levoča. Medieval **Levoča**, a former **royal town** and a gem of the Spiš region, is one of Slovakia's top destinations. Nestled at the foothills of **Slovak Paradise National Park**, its historic main square draws visitors **worldwide**. It features grand burgher mansions, the Gothic **Church of St. Jacob** with the world's largest wooden altar, and well-preserved city walls.

Overnight: Levoča

Day 2: Hiking Adventure through the Prielom Hornád Canyon

This morning you transfer 20 min to the heart of **Slovak Paradise National Park**, where you start your self-guided hiking adventure with a hike through the 13km **Prielom Hornádu canyon**. A 13km-long section of the river cuts through a **gorge**, and **ladders, bridges** and **cat walks** take you along and up it. The most visited part is the **Tomasovsky Vyhlad** rock gallery, where a 200m limestone rock rises up from the **Hornád River** and provides stunning views of the park. In the late afternoon you return back to your hotel.

Walking: 6 hours, 13km/8mi, 419m up, 412m down

Overnight: Levoča

Day 3: Hike through the Suchá Belá Canyon via the ruins of the Carthusian Monastery

Today's walk is a fairly adventurous circular route. Starting in a popular tourist centre, **Podlesok**, you'll go through the most romantic gorge in Slovakia, **Suchá Belá** – a world of **cascades, waterfalls** and **gorges**. Walking through the canyon involves crossing exposed sections of the **gorge** on **ladders, steps, bridges** and chains. The descent back to Podlesok will be on relatively easy terrain on comfortable forest roads and paths, and you will stop at the ruins of a **Courtesan monastery**, hidden in the heart of the **Slovak Paradise National Park**.

Walking: 6 hours, 13km/8mi, 428m up, 428m down

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch

Overnight: Levoča

Day 4: Transfer back to airport

Enjoy a smooth transfer back to your preferred airport, where your adventure comes to an end.

Poprad or Krakow: Which One to Choose?

Poprad-Tatry International Airport, Slovakia

For the most convenient journey, we recommend flying from London Luton or London Stansted to Poprad-Tatry, nestled in the stunning foothills of the High Tatras. Krakow International Airport, Poland

If flying to Poprad-Tatry isn't convenient, you can also fly to **Krakow**, which offers a wide range of international flights. For an additional fee, you can **book a private transfer** from Krakow Airport directly to your hotel. The journey takes about 2 hours and 30 minutes.
