# Itinerary

### Day 1: Welcome to Bratislava, Slovakia!

After arriving at **Bratislava Airport**, your family will enjoy a 20-minute transfer to your hotel in the heart of **Bratislava's charming Old Town**. Once you've checked in and settled in, take some time to relax and get ready for the exciting adventures ahead!

# Day 2: A Fun-Filled Family Day in Bratislava

**Bratislava** is a great place for a family day out! Start at **Bratislava Castle**, where you can enjoy amazing views, open spaces, and interesting exhibits. Then, walk through the **Old Town**, with its cobblestone streets, colorful buildings, and hidden courtyards. After a tasty lunch at a traditional restaurant, spend the afternoon exploring the city's many fun attractions at your own pace.

# Day 3: Train to the High Tatras, Slovakia's greatest mountains and the oldest national park.

Today, it's time to swap the city streets for mountain peaks as you travel to **Slovakia's greatest mountains** – **the High Tatras**! Hop on a scenic train ride, a fun and comfortable way for the whole family to enjoy Slovakia's countryside. In just over three and a half hours, you'll arrive in **Poprad-Tatry**, the gateway to the mountains.

The High Tatras are like a real-life fairy tale—sparkling lakes, **cascading waterfalls**, colourful wildflowers, **deep valleys**, and **towering peaks**. This untouched paradise is also home to **fascinating wildlife**, so watch for eagles soaring above or marmots playing in the meadows!

Once you reach **Poprad**, our friendly driver will be waiting to take you to your hotel in **Smokovec**, a charming mountain village in the heart of the Tatras.

After checking in, take a relaxing family stroll to explore Smokovec and soak in the fresh alpine air. Your Tatras adventure starts here!

# Day 4: Cable car to Skalnate Pleso, then walk to mountain huts and waterfalls.

This morning, take a scenic tram to **Tatranska Lomnica** and a cable car to **Skalnate Pleso** (1,751m), a crystal-clear mountain lake beneath **Lomnicky Peak (2,634m)**. Hike a family-friendly trail through the Tatras, passing mountain huts and waterfalls. Enjoy lunch at **Zamkovskeho hut**, visit **Cold Creek** waterfalls, and explore **Rainerova hut**, the oldest in the Tatras.

Walking: 4,5hrs, 11km/6,8mi, 400m up, 400m down.

Meals included: Breakfast, Packed Lunch

Overnight: Smokovec



# Day 5: Raft, Hike & Bike: Explore Pieniny National Park

Start your day with an exhilarating 9 km rafting trip through the stunning 23km Dunajec Gorge, surrounded by towering cliffs and lush forests. Perfect for families, this adventure is even suitable for younger children! After a tasty lunch at a traditional restaurant, cycle along the scenic Dunajec River to the legendary Red Monastery. Discover its fascinating stories, including the tale of monk Cyprian, before returning to your hotel.

Walking: 20 minutes, 1km/0,6mi, 0m up, 22m down

Cycling: 1 hour, 8km/4,9mi, 73m up, 67m down

Meals included: Breakfast

Overnight: Smokovec

### Day 6: Tatra Tram to Strbske Pleso & Hike to Skok Waterfall

Hop on the Tatra tram to **Štrbské Pleso**, the highest village in Slovakia, passing through charming spa villages and enjoying stunning mountain views. From there, set off on a scenic hike to **Skok Waterfall**, a perfect family-friendly adventure surrounded by lush alpine meadows. Keep an eye out for Tatra chamois and other wildlife as you explore. Enjoy a picnic with breathtaking views before returning to Štrbské Pleso, where you can relax by the glacial lake before taking the tram.

Walking: 3 Hours, 11km/7mi, 462m up, 462m down

Meals included: Breakfast, Packed Lunch

Overnight: Smokovec

# Day 7: Explore UNESCO sites: Spissky Castle & Levoca, then train to Bratislava

Today, we explore two of Slovakia's most remarkable UNESCO sites: Spiš Castle and Levo?a.

Our adventure begins at **Spiš Castle**, Central-Eastern Europe's largest castle complex. With breathtaking views and sprawling ruins, it's the perfect place for kids to roam and imagine medieval life.

Next, we visit Levo?a, a beautifully preserved medieval town at the foothills of Slovak Paradise National Park. Surrounded by historic city walls, it boasts the Basilica of St. James, home to the world's tallest wooden altar, and the elegant Town Hall. After exploring, we'll enjoy lunch at a traditional medieval-style restaurant.

In the afternoon, we board a scenic train from Poprad back to Bratislava.

To end your journey on a high note, we recommend a farewell dinner at the **UFO restaurant**, where panoramic views of the Danube River and Old Town create the perfect final memory of Slovakia.
