# Itinerary

# Day 1: Welcome to Prague!

Arrive in Prague and enjoy a comfortable group transfer to your hotel. Meet your group's tour leader and other families for an introductory meeting, where you'll learn about the exciting plans for the next seven days. Depending on your arrival time, you'll have some free time to explore this beautiful city's charming streets and iconic sights.

## Day 2: Family Adventure in Prague, then overnight train to the Tatra Mountains

Discover the historic centre with a local guide as you stroll through narrow streets, medieval squares, and iconic landmarks like Charles Bridge and the Orloj astronomical clock. In the evening, board the sleeper train to Slovakia's High Tatras—a fun and memorable experience for the kids!

## Day 3: High Tatras Adventure: Lakes, Huts & Waterfalls

After arriving in Poprad, transfer to your hotel and enjoy a relaxing morning before your first adventure. Grab a packed lunch and take a cable car to Skalnate Pleso, a crystal-clear lake with stunning views of Lomnicky Peak. Hike past mountain huts and waterfalls before ending in Stary Smokovec and returning to Tatranska Lomnica by tram.

## Day 4: Explore Spissky Castle, UNESCO Levoca & Relax at AquaCity Poprad

A short drive takes you to the impressive 12th-century Spissky Castle, one of Central-Eastern Europe's largest. A local guide will share fascinating stories, bringing the history to life for kids. Explore medieval Levoca, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before heading to AquaCity Poprad for fun in thermal pools, water slides, and relaxation.

# Day 5: Mountain Tram to Strbske Pleso & Hike to Skok Waterfall

Begin your day with a scenic mountain tram ride through the Tatras' charming spa villages to Strbske Pleso (1,347m), Slovakia's highest village, home to a stunning mountain lake. Follow a family-friendly trail to Skok waterfall, where cascading waters and tranquil pine forests create the perfect setting for a family adventure. Enjoy a packed lunch by the falls before hiking back to Strbske Pleso and returning to Smokovec by tram.

Walking: 4,5hrs, 11km/6,8mi, 400m up, 400m down. Overnight: Smokovec

# Day 6: Raft, Hike, Bike: Explore the National Park of Pieniny

After breakfast, transfer to Pieniny National Park, a natural border with Poland. Start with familyfriendly rafting through the stunning Dunajec Gorge, surrounded by forested peaks. After lunch, enjoy a scenic ride along the Dunajec River to Cerveny Klastor (Red Monastery). Discover its history before driving to Krakow for the night.

# Day 7: Family Adventure in Krakow

Krakow, a UNESCO World Heritage City, is famed for its Old Town, which features city walls, 46



spires, narrow streets, and Europe's largest medieval market square. Enjoy a family-friendly guided tour, then spend the afternoon exploring Krakow. For a deeper historical experience, choose an optional visit to the Wieliczka Salt Mines or Auschwitz concentration camp.
